Complaint: [REDACTED], complainant, emailed the Office of Police Oversight stating the following:

“I’m a professional photographer who recently moved to Austin from Seattle. I was standing close to [REDACTED] when he was shot. I have photos of the incident. I’ve got photos of officer [REDACTED] (badge [REDACTED]) laughing as [REDACTED] bleeds out on the ground, shots of people carrying [REDACTED] to safety, and shots of police (officer [REDACTED] crew) opening fire on the medics who were trying to get him to the ambulance. A lawyer friend of mine suggested contacting you about this. I am absolutely appalled and disgusted with the APD's handling of this situation. Officer [REDACTED] conduct was shameful and a disgrace to all of the good officers out there. There is no excuse for a trained officer to be laughing at an innocent man, twitching and bleeding out from the back of his skull. Here's my account of the incident:
