NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On October 10, 2022, the OPO received an online complaint.

The complainant alleges: I filed a case for my truck being broken into and property being stolen. No one was sent out to my truck to look and the detective didn't actually do any investigation for a year. I provided evidence of the persons who broke into my truck and stole my property. This includes a recorded phone call from one of the people admitting they did it, screenshots of facebook posts, and messages of them admitting to it. Detective [REDACTED] has drug his feet on everything, talked to two people, and has actively encouraged me to drop this case and ignore it. When I contacted APD Oversight to file a complaint, I got an email stating I would be contacted in 30 days. That was over a year and a half ago and no one contacted me by email or left me a voicemail or even a text. I have followed up numerous times but have only met walls of resistance.

This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.
