NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On May 16, 2022, the OPO received an email complaint.

The complainant alleges: This is a request for assistance in recovering damages for a auto collision between an APD vehicle and my S10 Blazer. An unknown APD officer collided with my parked S10 Blazer while on my property at [REDACTED]. I became aware of the collision after finding a brief and anonymous note affixed to the Blazer windshield on [REDACTED]. The note listed a report number of [REDACTED]. Numerous attempts failed to verify this report. However, the report appears to be [REDACTED] and incorrectly details a city vehicle damaged at [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] hrs. I believe the officer involved was responding to a domestic violence call at [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Refer to APD incident report [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] hrs. I was never contacted in any other way by any officer or city entity. I need to claim an amount of damages as a result of the collision. Please direct me to the proper department or city representative who can process such a claim. I would like internal affairs to investigate the anonymous cryptic note, the incorrect information in the incident report, and why APD failed to follow up on this collision.

This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.
