NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On April 5, 2022, the OPO received an online complaint.

The complainant alleges: I was in a car accident on [REDACTED]. I was hit by a Tesla and I was at a complete stop. The Tesla drove into oncoming traffic attempting to pass me to get to the light on [REDACTED]. The officer in question spent one minute with me, ignored my (female) nonbiased witness and flicked his hand at her, and then he spent about forty-five minutes with the other driver. The other driver had just finished yelling at me at the top of his lungs. I have attempted to get footage from the scene from the officer's vest but have heard nothing. My question is: is austin police department sexist? My case number is [REDACTED]. The fact that everyone had stopped and this other driver sped up after being behind twenty vehicles goes to show he had road rage and wanted to hit me. I will say this that one of the officers did speak with my witness but that did not make it into the officer's report.

This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.
