<p>Complaint:</p> <p>The complainant alleges: On [feb 1] at approximately [12:28pm], I called 911 to report an incident involving forced entry, physical injury, and property damage at my residence. A male individual named [REDACTED], who does not reside in my living space, attempted to force open a secured gate leading into my occupied area. He repeatedly kicked the gate in an effort to break through it while I was physically holding it shut to prevent entry. During this forced entry attempt, I sustained a deep laceration to my finger, which was bleeding heavily. When officers arrived, [REDACTED] had already left the scene. The officers spoke with the landlord first before speaking with me. When I explained what occurred and showed my injured finger, the responding officer dismissed the incident, stating that because the landlord gave [REDACTED] permission to be on the property, nothing could be done unless I suffered extreme bodily harm. Despite visible injury and my direct request, no photographs were taken of my wound or the damaged gate, and no meaningful investigation was conducted. I was not offered medical assistance, and the injury was not documented in the report. I was only provided with a report number. Additionally, during this response, one officer attempted to treat an informal, non-court eviction notice as legally binding and directed me to comply with it, despite it not being a court-issued eviction order. I was also instructed regarding vehicle placement and registration, while the violent incident itself was largely disregarded. I am filing this complaint due to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Failure to properly investigate an assault and attempted forced entry 2. Failure to document physical injury and property damage 3. Failure to collect evidence 4. Dismissive conduct toward a victim of physical injury 5. Improper legal guidance regarding eviction enforcement <p>This incident represents a serious safety concern, and I fear further escalation. I respectfully request a formal review of the responding officers' conduct, body camera footage, and incident handling, and that my injury and property damage be properly added to the official report.</p>

The whole dispute was because i said i didnt want to walk my dog and shouldnt be a responsibility as a 16 year old, which i learned i was lawfully not correct however my point does still stand that its unfair to have a 16 year old to have the full responsibility for a dog i didnt want in the first place, they said i was selfish for that and even sided with my sisters as well who called me selfish and lazy which is so disrespectful because i know im neither or those labels nor am i arrogant.he said "if there are three adults are saying youre the problem then dont you think youre the problem ?" hes job was to be mutual instead of being bias and calling me selfish and arrogant , i also felt a little made fun of because i said i was focusing on school work and it shouldnt be my responsibility to be the one mainly taking care of the dog, and one of the officers said "well your grades are already bad" so basically saying me focusing on school wasnt doing enough which i didnt understand why that was even said!! it was honestly irrelevant.. this made me feel even worse all the comments i was told by 5 adults. my two sisters my mom AND law enforcement, all i wanted was a mediator for the situation because of the arguing instead they left me feeling worse than i did before and made it seem like i was the issue. i also mentioned that my mom wanted to get me evaluated and i believe one of the officers agreed im not sure. I do recall one of them saying there was something wrong with me in the head which is also so unprofessional to tell a 16 year old that can lead to feelings of insecurity and distress. i honestly felt so disrespected during these conversations, i came to them vulnerable, even started crying and they just dismissed my feelings and called me selfish and arrogant and said something was wrong with me in the head. all i want is for someone to have a conversation with them to tell them how they handled my situation was very unprofessional. i get it they arent trained for those type of situations however its not hard to stay neutral instead of agreeing with the comments my sisters made calling me selfish and basically made me feel singled out.</p>

This happened to me tonight (~11:45PM or so, 1/29/2026 at a QT near Joseph Clayton Rd.). The police showed up and stopped right near my car, and then just hovered there then they slowly meander around my vehicle. It wasn't until I focused my phone camera on them that they finally up and left. But this is the 3rd instance of stalker behavior I've seen from this police force in the space of 2 months. They've already rushed my car twice; Officer Aziz was stalker #2, and now I gotta deal with this! I'm at a GAS STATION and now these stupid rent-a-cops can't even let me eat at a gas station in peace. I'll be submitting these complaints regarding this police force whenever they happen now, because I'm getting tired of the total lack of professionalism taking place here. I DO have video of the police capture, but your form will not allow the submission of .MOV files for some reason. This is the default format for iphone video captures. Give me an email address point of contact, and I can remit the video evidence that way. I'm now doubly suspicious of police conduct here now that this has taken place between your APD and your masked gestapo counterparts: https://www.kxan.com/news/local/austin/ice-calls-apd-for-assistance-after-crash-in-north-loop/ George Santayana provided a pretty clever way to describe what this police department has become: "A fanatic is someone who redoubles their efforts while losing sight of their aim." You are supposed to ensure public safety, not behave like a bunch of stalkers or behave like the criminals you're supposed to catch. APD is a disgrace! Nothing about what this department does has ANYTHING to do with safety. Just blatant hardcore racism and skullduggery. I have illnesses, so phone is not a reliable means of contact. Email only. <p>Complaint:</p> <p>The complainant alleges: I want to start by saying I completely understand that law enforcement deals with serious and urgent situations every day, and I respect that. I'm not expecting special treatment, or for the world to stop because my family has a burglary issue. But I have to be honest ...trying to report this burglary has been really frustrating and discouraging. My 14-year-old son's e-bike/trail bike has basically been stolen , worth around \$4,000-\$5,000 and something he worked REALLY hard for. When I called APD to report it, I expected to at least file a report and get a case number... Instead, I got bounced around from person to person, received conflicting information at every step, and still couldn't open a case or get a report number. I even tried online a few times, but once it came up as a motorized trail bike, the system wouldn't let me submit a report. One person even told me it wasn't a police matter and suggested I sue the person responsible ... mind you, that person is currently in jail. I honestly didn't know whether to laugh or cry. About 15 days later, we finally got a call back from Sergeant Javier, who has been professional, polite, and compassionate. He said he would forward the information to a detective assigned to a related case involving my son's e-bike. At this point, realistically, my chances feel slim, and I've mostly given up. We've always been hard-working, law-abiding people, paid our taxes, and never needed to contact the police. I tried to approach this patiently, knowing worse crimes happen every day. Still, when you call the burglary department to report a burglary and can't even start the process, it leaves you feeling dismissed. This experience has also made me understand how some people end up taking matters into their own hands. I'm sharing this mostly as feedback, hoping it highlights some gaps in communication and process that families like ours might run into. I'm not looking to assign blame . I just hope it helps improve how situations like this are handled. Right now, my son is struggling to believe that hard work matters, and this experience has made that lesson even harder for him to hold onto. Sincerely ████████████████████</p>

<p>Complaint:</p> <p>The complainant alleges: I am filing this complaint regarding inaccuracies, biased narrative framing, and unprofessional language in Austin Police Department General Offense Report [REDACTED]</p> <p>In this incident, I was listed as the victim of an Assault by Contact after another individual admitted to throwing hot coffee on me. However, the report minimizes the offender's conduct by framing it as unintentional while disproportionately focusing on my emotional state and behavior after the incident. The narrative shifts away from documenting the offense itself and instead emphasizes speculative characterizations about me that are unsupported by evidence.</p> <p>Specifically, the report includes the statement that I am "known to law enforcement as a violent offender," without referencing any charges, convictions, or case numbers. This assertion is factually unsupported, defamatory in nature, and inappropriate for an official police report. The report also speculates about my mental health status without clinical basis and uses casual, unprofessional phrasing that undermines the credibility of the document.</p> <p>Additionally, the report treats statements from multiple witnesses who are immediate family members of the offender as neutral corroboration without noting their relationship or potential bias, while failing to present my account with the same neutrality. This creates a misleading and unbalanced narrative.</p> <p>I am requesting review and correction of this report for accuracy, professionalism, and compliance with reporting standards, as the current version materially misrepresents events and unfairly damages my reputation</p> <p>Officer Description: Do you remember any details about the officer(s) you'd like to share?: Yes Name: Thomas Griffin III Physical description: The reporting officer was Officer Thomas Griffin III (AP6778), accompanied by Officer Christopher Gutierrez (AP8906). <p>Complaint:</p> <p>The complainant alleges: On Saturday, February 7, 2026, at approximately 2:00 AM, I was awakened by an officer aggressively pounding on my door. Upon opening it, I was confronted by an officer in full tactical gear who claimed a "geo-tracked" complaint had been made regarding an argument between an older adult and a child at my address. Despite my explanation that I live alone and my grandchildren had departed at 8:30 PM the previous evening, the officer's tone remained intimidating. He interrogated me regarding my family's whereabouts and my property (specifically my granddaughter's bicycle) before demanding entry to "check" the premises. His tone of voice with an obviously rattled senior adult was unacceptable. A second officer, not in full gear, arrived shortly after. Both entered my home; the first officer ordered me to stand in a specific area while he searched my upstairs rooms. The other officer stayed with me. After the search was completed, they vacated the premises. Unable to sleep, I contacted 311 at 3:30 AM to request clarification. At 3:45 AM, I received a voicemail confirming that the officers had targeted the wrong address. I subsequently learned that the officers had also gone to my neighbor's home at [REDACTED] causing significant distress to a visiting relative there. I am seeking a formal, written explanation detailing exactly how and why this error occurred. The distress caused by the nighttime intrusion was compounded the following morning when I discovered my vehicle had been vandalized. The car was covered in a thick, sticky residue, appearing as though a large beverage had been intentionally thrown over it. Given the sequence of events, I no longer feel this was a simple administrative error; I feel targeted and intimidated in my own home. I expect a full accounting of the "geo-tracking" error and the subsequent damage to my property. <p>Complaint: The complainant alleges:</p> <p>She and her boyfriend went to the gas station for gas and snacks. Her boyfriend got out of his truck and walked around the front to open her door. Officer Wise approached them and told them that if they were not going to get gas they needed to leave. Her boyfriend told the officers he was there to get snacks and gas. Officer Wise told him he did not like the tone of voice he was using, then placed the complainants boyfriend under arrest. The complainant asked why he was arresting her boyfriend instead of detaining him. Officer Wise told her that he smelled marijuana in the area, and that was probable cause to arrest him. The complainant stated the officers used force to arrest her boyfriend. She recorded the incident while the officers arrested her boyfriend. She asked if they had their body cam on. The officers told her to shut up and replied that they knew the law better than she did. She kept asking why her boyfriend was arrested. The officers arrested her too stating they had probable cause because they smelled marijuana in the truck. She stated the officers used force on her, threw her phone in the trunk, and may have deleted some of the videos she had taken. He patted her down. The complainant felt like officer Padilla- who arrested her boyfriend and told her to shut up- did not want to be there, was just following officer Wise and knew what they were doing was wrong. I was in the passenger seat asleep and had just been awakened moments before the stop. Officers initiated the traffic stop as we were entering the Whataburger parking lot.</p> <p>The initial interaction appeared routine. The officer stated my wife was “driving a little crazy,” but indicated that if her information returned clear, we would receive a warning and be allowed to leave.</p> <p>A second officer approached the passenger side and requested my identification. My identification was stored digitally on my phone, which had fallen during the stop. I verbally provided my legal name.</p> <p>We were initially cleared to leave.</p> <p>However, after departing, the officers followed us and initiated another stop. During this second encounter, the officer aggressively accused me of lying about my name, demanded that I exit the vehicle, and attempted to open the car door himself. I complied immediately and did not resist in any way.</p> <p>Upon exiting, I was grabbed by the arm, turned around, and placed in handcuffs.</p> <p>My minor children were seated in the backseat and witnessed their mother being physically restrained. They began screaming and crying in fear. Hearing my children cry in distress while I was handcuffed was deeply traumatic. I immediately began crying myself—not out of defiance,</p>	

but out of heartbreak that my children were forced to witness such a scene.

The following morning, my youngest child woke up still visibly upset and crying because she believed I was going to jail. No parent ever wants their children to see them in that light, especially when no crime was committed and no resistance was given.

While I was handcuffed, the officer retrieved my phone from inside my vehicle and required me to unlock it using facial recognition. He then navigated through my device to locate my digital identification. I did not consent to a search of my phone beyond providing identification.

It was later determined that the issue arose because my name had been misspelled when entered into the system. Once corrected, my record came back clear. There were no warrants and no violations.

Despite the unnecessary escalation, the physical restraint, the distress caused to my children, and the clear administrative error, no apology or acknowledgment of wrongdoing was provided.

I am deeply concerned by:

- The decision to re-initiate a stop after clearing us
- The aggressive escalation toward a non-resisting passenger
- The decision to handcuff me in front of minor children
- The search of my personal cellular device
- The lack of professionalism and accountability afterward

This incident has had an emotional impact on my family, particularly my children. I believe the situation escalated unnecessarily and disproportionately.

I am formally requesting:

1. A full internal investigation
2. Review of all body camera and dash camera footage
3. A written explanation for the detention, handcuffing, and phone search
4. Clarification of departmental policies regarding passenger identification and digital device searches

Please consider this matter serious. If this issue is not addressed appropriately and resolved through proper review, I am prepared to seek legal counsel and pursue further legal remedies to protect my rights and my family.

The postcard's return address was: Austin Police Department Sex Crimes PO Box 689001 etc. So everyone in her small town who handled that post card had the opportunity to know there was a sex crime committed in Austin involving my daughter, and she gets to wonder who is now "in the know" on something that she would prefer to keep private. That feels very much like re-traumatizing the victim, and I would strongly encourage a change in SOP for the Sex Crimes department. To make matters worse, the other side of the postcard contained the following instructions: "In order to further the investigation of the above incident in which you were involved, please telephone for an appointment with Det. Av.... (illegible smearing of the detective's name) of the Austin Police Department." That paragraph eliminates the possibility that [REDACTED] was just a witness, so anyone who had opportunity to lay eyes on this open postcard can be confident in knowing [REDACTED] was actually the victim of a sex crime. It seems that knowledge should be [REDACTED] to divulge to those she chooses. Those she knows to be a safe place. Those she knows to be trustworthy. Your Sex Crimes department exposed [REDACTED] victim status without her permission, making that knowledge accessible to whoever might have seen that postcard. (Landlord, roommate, anyone in the small-town post office...). I find the lack of compassion and sensitivity exhibited by sending that</p>	

information in an open postcard to be reprehensible, inexcusable, and, frankly, beyond comprehension in the age and society in which we live.

The other issue I find concerning is what I would consider an unacceptable lack of security on the part of your office. Not only is [REDACTED] name tied to a sex crime as the victim, the postcard actually lists – for public knowledge – the Incident Number and Incident Date. I am not technologically savvy enough to know if there is any way for someone with ill will to capitalize on that info; I do know that our world is full of people who would like to try. And unfortunately the fact that she has been a victim once is enough to encourage some people to consider her as a potential victim going forward; your department may have put a target on her back in the eyes of some low-lives.

Surely information like that could have been communicated to my daughter in a secure and private way. I am furious that your department has potentially compromised my precious daughter's safety, possibly re-traumatized her and delayed/complicated her healing process, and has made her second guess ever going to law enforcement for help in the future. I doubt that is your goal for your department. I exhort you, I encourage you, and – as a mum to a daughter who was assaulted in your city – I beg you to review and fix your communication SOP's for sex crimes. Thank you for your prompt and serious attention to this matter.
