### NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On September 15, 2022, the OPO received an online complaint.

**The complainant alleges:** I have information regarding a police lieutenant attempting to minimize one of his employees injuries in an attempt to avoid dealing with the fact that one of his supervisors assaulted one of their employees. The lieutenant knowingly submitting a workers compensation form that was not accurate. He failed to ensure that a workers compensation form was filled out when he was notified of the incident and failed to follow through on any type of action when he was advised of the assault between his staff. The assault occurred on [REDACTED] of this year. The Lieutenant tried to talk the victim out of writing a report stating that it would just be a class C and it wouldn't go anywhere.

[REDACTED] is the victim (a 911 call taker) of the assault that occurred at [REDACTED]. She was assaulted by a communications supervisor [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] emailed [REDACTED] supervisor [REDACTED] the night this happened on [REDACTED]. Lt. [REDACTED] has allowed [REDACTED] to remain working in the same building as the victim and has not made any attempts to keep the two from having contact with each other.

[REDACTED] was being trained at 911 by the victim [REDACTED] when the assault happened. She saw everything first hand.

*This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.*
