Officer-Involved Shooting Dashboard: Live Demonstration and Community Feedback

What We Heard

Transparency and Access to Information

- Participants requested additional information about body-worn camera audits beyond numerical reporting.
- Participants expressed interest in receiving additional context alongside reported data, including information about oversight processes, findings, outcomes, and how information is shared with the public.
- Questions were raised regarding updated APD complaint classifications, investigative outcomes, disciplinary recommendations, and how complaint-related information is tracked and reported.

Data Reporting and Dashboard Functionality

- Feedback included requests for additional data points to include officer tenure and demographic information
- Interest in downloadable data and expanded access to underlying datasets.

Community Education and Engagement

- Participants shared feedback related to current Know Your Rights resources
- Community members had questions regarding whether individuals with lived experience in the justice system are represented within oversight work and opportunities for community members to better understand available processes and services.
