### NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On August 5, 2022, the OPO received a phone complaint.

**The complainant alleges:** [REDACTED] [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] I talked to a Latino APD police officer, who was working off duty for a private construction site in an unmarked, unofficial black, Chevrolet truck (tag: [REDACTED]). They set up road closure signs so a construction crew can move freely on the ROW while they build new apartments at [REDACTED] Road. When I prompted for a road closure permit, the officer said he didn't have one and told me I was being recorded through his dashcam camera. I proceeded to inform the officer that I live southbound on [REDACTED] and I cannot get home without getting back on the highway and taking [REDACTED] exit. The officer told me go back to my vehicle and when I asked him for his name and badge number he refused to provide either one. The officer was wearing a green vest and under it he had his APD uniform. I then asked him "are you on duty?", he replied, "yes I am and I don't have to identify to you." I walked away and down the road I could hear him asking me to come back, but I refused after he tried to intimidate me with his personal dash camera. May I please have the name, badge number of this officer? Thanks!
