NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On May 24, 2022, the OPO received a phone complaint.

The complainant alleges: His car was taken by someone who he was trying to help out. While he was sick in the bathroom person took his keys and stole his car. He is a 65-year-old veteran with limited car insurance and cannot afford to buy another car. He wants his car to be listed as stolen and a BOLO issued. Someone in the auto theft division decided to profile him as a drug addict and blame him as the reason the car was taken. He could have had his car back [REDACTED] days ago if the officer who took his report and the auto theft division would have listed his car as stolen. They wanted him to send a demand letter to someone he does not know, nor does he know the person's address. Detective [REDACTED] e-mailed him requesting the VIN number and license plate number, but he had already turned that information over to the auto theft division.

This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.
