NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On July 25, 2022, the OPO received a phone complaint.

The complainant alleges: She was in an accident and felt safety was her best action, so she moved to a gas station off the roadway. The responding officer, [REDACTED], was more concerned with the other driver than her. Officer [REDACTED] found her at fault and ticketed her without hearing her side of the story. The accident happened at [REDACTED] but it took the police at the [REDACTED] till [REDACTED] to come talk to her. The officer yanked the paper and insurance out of her hand. The officer was very rude. The ticket is being dismissed because even the judge found the officer was very rude. The officer needs to have a class on communicating with people and not assuming one person is at fault. He even took the other driver to the [REDACTED] so he could catch his flight on time. He never even asked if she was injured.

This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.
