He told the complainant that they needed to set up interviews with all 5 parties and their children to build a strong case to get a warrant. At one point someone from APD said there was a date and time for an interview, the complainant showed up with her daughter, and no one was there. When she spoke to him about it, he said he didn't know what she was talking about. In April he finally sent a message to one of the parents involved saying he would call everyone to set up interviews. Everyone wanted to do the interviews, and everyone has been trying to set up these interviews. He told one of the parents that he was going to drop the case if no one wanted to set up interviews even though everyone has been trying for months to move this forward. The complainant wants to know how to make this case move forward.

One of the workers ran outside to tell them to drop their weapons and they refused despite having both men in handcuffs already with three officers on site. officer Kevin Garvey 6445 walked in and berated the worker who was attempting to get the police to deescalate the situation. both of the men being temporarily detained were black and I believe officer Garvey and the two other officers did not attempt to be reasonable in any way and were actively discriminating against the two men on the basis of their race. there was no need to put him on the ground or to point a weapon at him, even if he had a gun...the police should be able to handle this situation without resorting to violence.





Y Went into custody .y'all had suspicious I wasnt who I said I was talk gave me a DNA test . Cause y'all got info from multiple organizations people Integral Care Sunrise Pastor Mark just to name a few 17 days later y'all continuing to trash my name like I"m a drug dealer criminal mind you check the records before hand . y'all gas a whole dept misjudged me y'all trashed my name public y'all helped the city of Austin keep my driving license but to try to have me arrested everywhere y'all helped them write false documents claming whole I was in jail my family wrote a letter wrong yall helped them including [REDACTED] continuing to go around town saying I have aids I"m a junky bum homeless criminal y'all continuing to dehumanize me my own eyes I saw 2 officials with a woman after the try to run me off misusing there authority team up with her and say the most horrific things no code of ethics.
