Furthermore, my car was in perfect shape before after just having it fixed and it ended up vandalized under their care. I don't find be this even mildly amusing as my car is my way of coping with how hard it is to be your own hero and still be heroic to others. It's a super hero car besides.

Do you guys even have PR people anymore? Sensitivity training? Drug testing? Psych evaluation? Post war trauma counseling?

I should sue this whole city at this point. But I'm not that kind of douchebag, Perhaps, y'all could thin out the blue line again and make sure not to turn it into tire tracks over my constitutional rights.
