## NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On December 6, 2022, the OPO received an online complaint.

**The complainant alleges:** Recently a close friend of mine, Retired APD Officer [REDACTED] shared a disturbing incident with me involving his ex-girlfriend, Investigator [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told me that he had been assaulted by [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] after a party at a [REDACTED] in [REDACTED]. He told me that he did not make a report because he was worried about her daughter, embarrassed about the incident, and afraid he would be viewed poorly if the public found out because he was a [REDACTED] at the time it happened. He told me he has a photo of his injuries, but he didn't show it to me. I'm reporting this anonymously because I am disturbed that [REDACTED] was treated this way by someone who continues to be a police officer. I was even more bothered when I found out that she works in an important office that investigates sexual assaults. I have known [REDACTED] for many years, and I know he is too proud and embarrassed to report this, but I think it's the right thing to do.

*This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.*
