NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On December 5, 2022, the OPO received a phone complaint.

The complainant alleges: There were some guys that got on the bus downtown and tried to sell her drugs. She did do drugs for a while, but she quit so they began to threaten her. There was also an incident when a man exposed himself. She filed a report with transit for bus [REDACTED] complaint number [REDACTED]. She also called the police. APD told her to give them a little time because they were going to investigate. On the [REDACTED] she received a case number [REDACTED]. She is constantly hearing voices, but she does not see anyone talking but people are on their cell phones. When she calls for APD they will not investigate. Officer [REDACTED] badge [REDACTED] and Officer [REDACTED] badge [REDACTED] were at her apartment complex regarding another incident so she tried to get an update from them regarding her case because it has been weeks and she has not heard anything. The officers told her to contact OPO. She does have a knife because she has to be able to defend herself. She knows everything going on at [REDACTED]. When cops are called for a dead body they respond, but when it comes to her, they hit the machine and the police do not show up to help her.

This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.
