On October 14, 2022, the OPO received a phone complaint.

There were witnesses to the interaction. The police came and spoke to the complainant's wife and her brother and arrested his wife, who has a 1-year-old at home. The police didn't care what the witnesses had to say. How can the cops say they are the law and they decide what happened? The complainant wants to know why the witnesses' statements don't matter.

This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.
