### NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On December 28, 2022, the OPO received a phone complaint.

**The complainant alleges:** He hopes Internal Affairs, or the police will get involved concerning a truck that was wrecked and abandoned. [REDACTED], the first name [REDACTED], was the person driving a [REDACTED] with [REDACTED], license plate [REDACTED] and he had an unregistered gun in the vehicle. The complainant called 311 on the morning of [REDACTED] and left his name and number and nothing was done about it. The complainant made a report about a truck with a lot of solar equipment being wrecked and abandoned. The individual that wrecked the truck called him a snitch and all kinds of derogatory and racist names. The complainant reported the incident to 311 and when he called 311 back for a follow-up, he was told there was nothing they could do about it. The complainant does not know what steps to take. The complainant is in a legal situation right now and he is hoping APD can look deeper into the situation. He filed a police report with a detective but was told there was nothing they could do. He is complaining about why nothing was done. The driver of the wrecked vehicle had bruises from his chin to his mid-torso and one of his knees was badly bruised because the airbag deployed. The Driver of the wrecked vehicle pulled a gun on the complainant, so he called 911. The individual that wrecked the truck went to the police and told them the complainant was the one that caused the injuries to him. The gentleman lied to the police telling them he attacked him. There were visible bruises, so the complainant was arrested.

***This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.***
