NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On March 14, 2023, the OPO received an email complaint.

The complainant alleges: Sgt. [REDACTED] and Sgt. [REDACTED] Caller has a complaint saying they called the number that called them on [REDACTED], which is [REDACTED] and the time they called was at [REDACTED], [REDACTED]. When they called [REDACTED] the person who answered was rude to them and refused to help them regarding their stolen vehicle. They mentioned that the person with APD who answered told them that it was their cellphone, and the caller is wanting to know why they are conducting business using their cellphone. The caller has been refusing to contact the Office of the Police Oversight and says they trust providing us (311) the complaints instead.

Sgt. [REDACTED] spoke w/ [REDACTED] (caller) stated caller could not report his vehicle stolen. When asked what to do if the body shop would not report the vehicle stolen. When police went to body shop they contradicted the statement and told the him he could report it. Caller has report number [REDACTED]. Car was recovered by ignoring the officer and calling 911 10x in row to receive a response. [REDACTED] also wants to submit a complaint on Officer [REDACTED] (first caller) and Sgt. [REDACTED] (refused to provide badge number). Caller states Sgt. [REDACTED] also refused to give Sgt. [REDACTED] badge number after being asked for the badge number.

This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules
