They sped by the children and were about 4 feet from hitting one of them.</p>

The complainant states that APD arrived to the scene and took a report. The complainant states that the report was incorrect and placed her at fault for the accident. The complainant asserts that the other driver was clearly inebriated and at fault. The complainant believes that the Officers were unfair because she was Spanish Speaking.</p>

<p><b>Complaint:</b></p> <p>The complainant alleges:</p> <p>She was visiting her mother and noticed a decline in her health which the complainant attributed to dementia. She was awoken one night by a stun gun, thought it was an intruder, and ran out of the house. She ran down the street screaming and knocking on doors. A neighbor answered and let her use the phone to call the police. She realized that it was her mother who was using the stun gun on her in a hallucination that the complainant believes was brought on by dementia. She explained this to the police when they arrived, and requested her mother get taken to the ER and put on a 72 hour psych hold.</p> <p>She kept getting questioned by several officers, all asking the same questions. She became aggravated and decided to record her story in selfie mode, and in front of the officer's body cams so that she would not be forced to tell the story over and over again.</p> <p>The officers had her leave her neighbors house and go sit in an ambulance. While the EMT was drawing blood- which she believed was to check her blood pressure- she called her family and left messages to update them. An officer approached her while she was on the stretcher. She overheard an EMT whisper under their breath "schizophrenic" to the officer. She confronted the EMT worker and told them she was not schizophrenic and that she was seen by a psychologist.</p> <p>The officer made a comment about her seeing a psychologist which led the complainant to believe that the officers were questioning her mental health status and that they were placing this whole investigation on her and ignoring her request to have her mother taken to the hospital. She said she wanted to call her lawyer, and the officer said no- that she didn't need to call a lawyer and proceeded to try to take her phone away. They proceeded to tell her she was not attacked with a stun gun, and that she had no burn marks. They ended up sending her to the hospital for a 72 hour psych hold. The hospital workers all agreed that APD shouldn't have sent her to the hospital and should have sent her mother instead.</p> <p>She has been speaking with Officer Chris Frierson AP4578 who has been helpful in advising her on how to move forward with filing a complaint and who has validated her concerns about this case being mishandled by the officers on scene.</p>	

She identified an officer with the badge number AP10194 as one of the officers involved on scene

She was provided a case number 26500089- which Officer Frierson advised was incorrect and should read 2650089

<p>The complainant alleges:</p> <p>On Friday, Feb. 27, 2026, I was driving on Webberville Road, which intersects with North Pleasant Valley Road in East Austin. I saw a large black pickup truck with blue lights parked in the middle of the street. I didn't know whether there was an accident or disabled vehicle on the other side of the truck. So, I slowly proceeded to go around the left side of the truck to continue on the road. To my left, there were cars pausing, then proceeding through the stop sign. I thought they were coming through as part of a detour. I was stopped. That's when the Austin Police Officer came over quickly, with his hands in the air, yelling at me. I rolled down my window, and he said, "What are you doing?"</p> <p>I replied that I was trying to go around. And he said, "Can't you see this is a funeral procession?" I told him, "No," that I didn't know that. I don't live in Austin. Plus, there were no "funeral" placards on top of any of the vehicles, indicating that this was a funeral procession. I apologized, and he said, "What are you? Fuckin' stupid?"</p> <p>Then, he ran back to his truck and loudly pulled away.</p> <p>This is no way for anyone, much less a police officer, who is an employee of the City of Austin, to speak to anyone. His words and actions left me shaken, especially given the violence of ICE officers in other cities who've angrily approached vehicles when drivers are non-threatening. This officer should not be representing the City of Austin in any form or fashion. Should he be continued to be employed by the City of Austin, I would hope there would be mandatory training that he would need to complete before he is to resume serving the public.</p> <p>I don't have his name, but you have the location and date. The approximate time of this incident was 2:30 p.m. You can easily research which officer was assigned to cover a funeral and determine who this person is.</p> <p>Description: Male, Hispanic, 30s-40s, Height: approximately 5'7" or 5'8". Medium build with a rotund stomach. <p><b>Complaint:</b></p> <p>The complainant alleges:</p> <p>Statement Regarding Threat with a Knife and Lack of Arrest   Saturday, February 28, 2026  On Saturday, February 28, 2026, at around 7pm, my neighbor (who lives across from me), and I had a verbal altercation, and she lunged a knife at me twice. The action caused me to fear for my safety and constituted a serious and credible threat of physical harm, and per the police officers, a felony and assault.</p> <p>I called 911 and Austin Police Department (APD) police officers responded to the incident. I provided all the information to the police about what happened and what led to the verbal altercation (which is a pattern of stalking and harassment behavior by both neighbors living in that house. Per the police's request, I gave them a description of both people living there. I didn't point any weapon at her, and despite the presence of a weapon and threatening behavior by that neighbor, no arrest was made. APD police officers were more focused on scrutinizing and nitpicking things about me and the fact that I was talking to that neighbor (we were both talking on the video, fyi, but APD officers singled me out) to not make an arrest. This isn't the first time I called the police on that neighbor for the pattern of stalking behavior. Previous Incident#: 25-3381321</p> <p>This statement is made to provide an accurate record of the incident and its impact on my sense of safety and well-being. Being threatened with a deadly weapon is a serious matter, and the lack of immediate enforcement action is an ongoing concern for my personal safety.</p> <p>I am submitting this statement to seek review and appropriate actions, accountability, and protection under the law.</p> <p>Police Report# for this incident: 26-0591333 – ADP Police Officers on scene:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Officer Hart #9755</li> <li>- Officer Herrera #10068</li> <li>- Officer Lambrecht #10352</li> <li>- CPL. Odean #7325</li> </ul> <p>As a Black Woman, I never feel safe calling the police or confident that they will protect my safety. When I call 911 or when the police show up on scene, they belittle me, bully me, and sometimes I have to call 911 2-3 times before they decide to send police officers out. When CPL Odean showed up and I showed him the assault video, he can clearly see the person holding a knife and chasing</p>	

me around with it, but he kept belittling me, claiming “oh, it appears to be a knife” and “you’re saying something to her, you’re saying something to her again, and you’re saying something to her again”, that’s all I could hear him say, and acknowledging the assault, not holding the person who lunged the knife at me accountable. It’s like my life and safety is a joke to police officers and my life doesn’t matter. – In a heated argument with someone, exchanging words is not illegal nor a felony; lunging a knife, a gun, or any type weapon at someone and chasing them around with the knife (the weapon) however is a felony and assault, as stated by one of the officers on scene. An arrest should have been made, and I shouldn’t have been made to feel like “I got what I deserved” and that my life and safety are up for debate.

<p><b>Complaint:</b></p> <p>The complainant alleges:</p> <p>On 3/6/2026, I turned from 5th Street onto the southbound I-35 frontage road and was preparing to make a U-turn from the leftmost lane. At that point, a police vehicle rapidly approached from behind and stopped extremely close to my rear bumper before activating its lights.</p> <p>It took me a moment to realize that the officer was initiating a traffic stop. Once I understood that I was being pulled over, I signaled and began moving to the right in order to safely exit the intersection and pull over.</p> <p>Before I was able to fully pull over, the officer exited his vehicle and began shouting loudly, throwing his hands in the air and yelling at me while I was still attempting to move safely to the side of the road. The officer appeared to believe I was not complying, but I was actively trying to pull over in a safe location and had no intention of fleeing or ignoring the stop.</p> <p>The officer then told me that I should have stopped immediately in the middle of the intersection once he exited his vehicle. I did not see him exit his car, and in my experience as a driver, stopping in the middle of an active intersection feels unsafe. My intention was simply to pull over safely and comply with the stop.</p> <p>The officer's aggressive driving prior to the stop, including following extremely closely to my vehicle, combined with screaming and gesturing at me in the intersection made the entire interaction feel unnecessarily escalated and unsafe.</p> <p>I have lived in Austin for over 30 years and have had multiple interactions with the Austin Police Department during that time. All of my previous encounters with officers have been calm and professional. This experience was very different.</p> <p>Throughout the incident, I was attempting to comply with the officer and safely pull over. However, the officer's behavior, including aggressive driving and shouting, created a situation that felt intimidating and unsafe, particularly in a busy I-35 frontage road intersection.</p> <p>Because of how the situation was handled, I felt it was important to report the interaction.</p> <p><b>Officer description:</b></p> <p>Physical description: I don't remember his name, and he did not introduce himself. Despite my full cooperation, both cases were closed without explanation. I repeatedly asked for help and provided information, yet these admissions were not investigated. There was no meaningful coordination with law enforcement, and no intervention occurred that ensured my safety or the safety of my children. As a result of the abuse, I now suffer from ongoing physical injuries, including accelerated arthritis caused by the harm inflicted on me. Part of my necessary regimen for my spinal condition is to swim which is why I moved to the current premises. I had been unable until that time to find a quiet time to swim because there had been extreme partying and publicly intoxicated people every night at the pool (I work during the day). I decided to try to go out and ask if I could please use just one side of the pool. There was a group of people, about 8 or more. I asked them if I could use one side and began to enter the pool. I was immediately confronted by the group who seemed very intoxicated and began splashing me and surrounding me so I couldn't begin to swim. I tried to go around them, and one began verbally harrassing me and another of the women began physically obstructing my ability to swim. At this point I told them to stop, but they just kept the same activity going on. I decided to get out of the pool because by this time I was surrounded by the group and they were threatening me. I told them I would call authorities if they didn't stop, which they didn't. I got out at this point as I was very frightened and went to get my keys. While I was distracted some of them had taken my keys with the building entry fob on it so I couldn't exit the pool to get away from them. By this time I was terrified as I was locked in with them. Fortunately, someone in the adjoining billiard room opened the door for me as he saw me knocking on the window. I ran to my apartment as I was frightened and didn't know what to do and had no clothes or key fob to enter my apartment with. I knocked first on the door of my neighbor who came to the door and told me to the apartment across from me. I did that and it turned out to be the assistant manager (I did not know she lived there). She called the manager who was offsite, put her on speaker. The manager began screaming at me to "just call the police". I pointed out to her that the police could not make me a fob to enter my apartment. At this point she told the assistant manager to go make me a fob, which she did. She was gone some time, at I went around the corner to see where she was as I was very cold, and saw her talking to one of the girls in the group that had threatened me. She then went to get the fob made and returned. I thanked her and went into my apartment. I was very, very upset that night and couldn't sleep. I have PTSD from being in a near fatal car accident, and when I am threatened I just seek safety. The angry reaction of the manager had not made sense, her lack of asking what happened for caring for my safety had really frightened me. When I signed my lease I specifically asked if there was a security officer in place and was told there was. It became immediately apparent that was</p>	

not the case as the behavior at the pool nightly had included people who were very publicly intoxicated in large groups after hours, and the supposed number for security went nowhere: no way to leave a message or anyone answering just an AI assistant that would greet and then nothing. This continues, however as apparently as of a week ago we have a security officer. Emergency numbers were not posted outside the office either. The following morning of the incident I called 911 and TCSO responded. They then interviewed me. After this incident the manager the next day retaliated against me and my neighbor with lease violations. Her retaliation seems to be for knocking on the door of my neighbor for help, calling this a "disturbance". Since then, I have requested in writing for the pool area to stay lit at night and for the pool area to be lit at night, as it was when I first moved in. These requests have been ignored. There have been many fights in the hallways of the building and TCSO has been here many times. After some time I was able to talk to a detective assigned to my case and was able to read the summary of the case. Apparently the property manager lied to the deputies and told them I had been out at the pool making disturbances regularly before the incident. I had never been at the pool before that night because of fear. I was also able to identify, through social media, some of the people who were involved in this incident, all non residents except for one that I am aware of and gave this info to TCSO in an AXON report. Our rules are only 2 people per resident. The manager was apparently retaliating against me because I had complained that it was apparent that she lied to me when I signed my lease, telling me that there was security and then when that became apparent it was not the case (I live next to the pool) I complained to her of lack of lighting and of the other infractions (after hours late night partying, stripping, etc, extreme PI). I just received another notice that my lease will not be renewed. While doing research on this landlord, I realized that they are the same management company that managed the last place I lived, which had the same security issues, APD responded to. These people operate under different names. The last building I lived at was called [REDACTED]. The management company there called themselves [REDACTED] and their office was in [REDACTED] at that time. The managing directors names are the same as this property, they just made another [REDACTED]. These people are very bad. I was in a 5 story building and they allowed the elevator to be brokend, claiming they couldn't get the part. This went on 2 years or more. I called city inspectors who just kept accepting their story. They building, a brand new one, became run down, no security after hours, lots of drug dealing, illegal vehicles with paper plates on them, hit and runs in the parking lot. When the management finally changed, the elevator was magically fixed almost instantly. This company need to be investigated. They don't seem to employ people who have any property management training or realty law training. When an incident happens, the employee involved get fired and a new one who is just as incompetent replaces them. I believe OAG needs to investigate these people for numerous violations of tenant safety, retaliation. My TCSO incident # is 252060285. I have numerous pictures, paperwork and videos relating to these properties. Records of my elevator complaints were escalated to the oversight office for inspectors as the inspector seemed to ignore written complaints about [REDACTED]. I will send a copy of this letter to the OAG. APD officers called out about parking in handicap spaces, which were very limited, by people I couldn't communicate with because of language barriers were basically ignored, just like the inspector reports, and I felt intimidated by the officers so I just gave up and moved. Now I will have to move again because no one is assisting tenants who are having issues with these big property managment companies. Meanwhile, I have also notified AFDC about this situtation as there seems nowhere safe to live in Austin/Cedar Park and these peopled are preying on the elderly and disabled (my neighbor is also elderly and disabled as were most of the people at [REDACTED]).

<p><b>Complaint:</b></p> <p>The complainant alleges:</p> <p>Dear APD Records Division, Traffic Investigations, and Office of Police Oversight, I am writing to formally document a phone call I received today, March 24, 2026 at 4:04 PM from APD Officer Scott (Badge #7104, phone: 737-228-8611) regarding my Supplemental Report Request for GO# 2025-3401214 (TxDOT Case ID: 21166309). I am filing this as both a formal objection to the refusal of my supplemental report request and a formal complaint regarding Officer Scott's conduct during this call.</p> <p><b>SUMMARY OF OFFICER SCOTT'S STATEMENTS DURING THE CALL</b></p> <p><b>1. IMPROMPTU STATEMENT OFFER</b></p> <p>When I raised the issue of my statement never being taken at the scene, Officer Scott responded: "If your statement is missing, tell me now." This approach offering to take a statement verbally over a casual phone call rather than through a formal supplemental report process — is not an adequate substitute for a documented supplemental report and does not address the four documented contradictions between the CR-3 and the HALO4 CAD record.</p> <p><b>2. REFUSAL TO REVIEW VIDEO EVIDENCE</b></p> <p>When I asked how a liability determination could be finalized without reviewing the available video footage, Officer Scott responded that he reads many crash reports and cannot review the video for every one. Officer Scott's explicit admission that he does not review video footage for every report constitutes a failure to perform a mandatory investigative duty when such objective evidence is known to exist within the department's own Axon/Evidence.com system. The APD HALO camera footage (POD160, 18:33:30–18:34:19) was officially preserved by APD Officer Valdez (AP6712) precisely for evidentiary purposes. Closing this investigation without reviewing it is an investigative failure.</p> <p><b>3. CAD RECORD DISMISSED AS "CIVIL WORKER"</b></p> <p>Officer Scott stated that the HALO4 CAD entry was made by a "civil worker" — not a sworn officer — and on this basis refused to treat it as relevant to the CR-3. The employment status of the HALO4 observer — sworn or civilian — is irrelevant to the admissibility and reliability of the record. These are business records maintained in the regular course of APD's operations, generated by APD personnel, in APD's own systems, about an event captured on APD's own cameras. Dismissing them on the basis of the observer's employment classification is a violation of the integrity of the department's own reporting systems.</p>	

4. "THIS IS HOW WE DO IT"

When I raised the fact that two independent witnesses were present in my vehicle — documented by name and address in the APD CAD record — and were never included in the CR-3, and that no speed analysis was conducted before Contributing Factor #37 was assigned solely to me, Officer Scott responded: "This is how we do it." This is not an adequate explanation for an incomplete official record.

5. "YOU JUST WANT TO CLEAR YOURSELF"

When I stated that my account of the collision is consistent with the HALO4 CAD record — that my vehicle was stopped and the other vehicle was at high speed — Officer Scott responded with words to the effect of: "You just want to clear yourself." This characterization is inappropriate. By refusing to interview the two documented independent witnesses and by failing to take my statement at any point in the 110+ days following the collision, APD has produced an incomplete CR-3 based solely on the adverse driver's self-serving account. I am not asking APD to find me not at fault. I am asking APD to document what was omitted.

6. INABILITY TO ASSESS SPEED

When I cited the HALO4 CAD entry documenting that Unit 2 appeared to be traveling at a high rate of speed in a 25 mph posted zone, Officer Scott responded: "I can't determine speed. I don't have a laser to measure it." The HALO4 entry does not require an independent speed measurement — it is a real-time observation by APD personnel reviewing the collision footage. Dismissing a documented APD observation on the grounds that precise speed cannot be independently verified after the fact is not a valid basis for ignoring that record.

7. REFUSAL TO ENGAGE WITH APPLICABLE LAW

When I referenced the applicable Texas Transportation Code provision, Officer Scott stated words to the effect of: "We keep going in circles. I'm not going to do what you're asking." He then ended the call.

FORMAL REQUESTS

I am formally requesting that this matter be escalated to a supervisor with authority over both the Traffic Investigations Unit and the Real Time Crime Center records. Please confirm in writing:

1. The specific APD policy or authority cited for refusing to file a supplemental report
2. The name and contact information of the supervisor or division with authority to review this refusal
3. Whether APD HALO camera footage (POD160, 18:33:30–18:34:19) was reviewed prior to closing this investigation
4. Whether the two independent witnesses documented in the APD CAD record — [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] — were ever contacted as part of this investigation
