### NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On March 29, 2022, the OPO received an online complaint.

**The complainant alleges:** To who it may concern: Sargent [REDACTED] badge number [REDACTED] came into my establishment [REDACTED] and found a wallet in my lobby, when we asked for it she stated she was going to turn it in. I have been in the restaurant and bar industry for 24 years and every time someone leaves something in my establishment I have returned it to the guest because the guest was here at my place of business. Sargeant [REDACTED] insisted she is a cop and will turn it into the city and file a report. That makes no sense to me because it is my responsibility, I do not understand why she is flexing that she is a cop, we see your badge, we know you are a cop but that wallet was one of my customers, he did not go into the police station. Sargeant [REDACTED] was in my place of business, she should have let me do my job that I have been doing for 24 years. She did not have to take that wallet out of my restaurant and she did not have to file a report. I do not understand what her ego trip is about. Can you please let her superior know and have him reach out to me?
