NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On August 22, 2022, the OPO received a phone complaint.

The complainant alleges: He owns a [REDACTED] business, and his life and business were threatened by an individual who said he was very rich and could do whatever he wanted. The individual then threw his [REDACTED] stuff around and slapped him on the [REDACTED] looking him right in the eye. There were multiple witnesses, and the police officer recorded the entire situation of the individual saying, “it was just a pat on the [REDACTED]”. The complainant heard the officer say to the individual that it was assault, but he filed it as a disturbance. He was told by the officer that there was nothing he could do even though the individual admitted it was just a slap on the [REDACTED] and he would beat his [REDACTED]. The officer told the complainant the only thing he could do is move forward in municipal court. After speaking to multiple attorneys, the complainant was told what happened was a terroristic threat and because he put his hands on him that is something police should have moved forward with criminal charges. He is willing to press charges and he wants to know why the person did not get a ticket and why APD told him the only option was to move forward in municipal court to do anything to protect himself. He wants to know what options he has to protect himself and why the police were not able to help him. Case # [REDACTED]/Responding officer [REDACTED]

This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.
